



TRUST DEED


THIS DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST is made at Patna this Both Day of December 2019 by



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RAJ KISHORE S/O Vidya Nand Singh resident of Prabha Niwas, Mohar Tola, Dariyapur Gola, P.O - Bankipur, P.S - Kadamkuan, Dist. - Patna - 800004 religion Hindu, hereinafter called as Author of The Trust, which expression shall wherever the context so permits mean and include its successors-in-office of the ONE PART;

WHEREAS THE AUTHOR OF THE TRUST decides to create and establish a Trust to impart education and to provide other charitable activities for the welfare of the community at large without discrimination of caste, religion or etc. with objects and constitution as hereinafter set forth;

AND WHEREAS the said object in view, the AUTHOR OF THE TRUST has decided to endow the said TRUST a nucleus of Rs. 51,000/- (Rupees Fifty One Thousand only) in cash and this Trust shall be constituted and administered in accordance with the terms of this DEED OF TRUST and rules and regulation framed hereunder.

AND WHEREAS the following persons agreed to act as the first trustees:

- (i) RAJ KISHORE, S/O Vidya Nand Singh resident of Prabha Niwas, Mohar Tola, Dariyapur Gola, P.O – Bankipur, P.S-Kadamkuan, Dist. - Patna - 800004
- (ii) BIRENDRA KUMAR SINGH, S/O RAM JATAN SINGH resident of Dahaurchak, P.O.- Patariya, Dist.-Jehanabad, Bihar-804454
- (iii) SULEKHA DEVI, D/O SHRI BHAGVAN SINGH, Vill. Basiyawan, P.O. – Kalyanpur, P.S - Pipra, Dist. Patna - 804453

AND WHEREAS the Trustees have accepted the obligation under this Trust and agreed to function as Trustee under the terms of this Deed and to discharge the obligation of the Trust set out hereinafter.

NOW THIS DEED OF DECLARATION OF THE TRUST WITNESSED AS FOLLOWS:

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1. CREATION OF THE TRUST

In pursuance of the intention, the AUTHOR OF THE TRUST has settled the sum of Rs. 51,000/- (Rupees Fifty One Thousand only) by cash unto and in favour of the Trustees named hereinafter to be held by them for and on behalf of the Trust hereby created and known as "COMENIUS EDUCATIONAL TRUST"

2 AREAOFOPERATION:

Area of operation of the trust shall be whole of India as well as abroad.

3 PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE TRUST:

The Principal office of the trust shall be situated at Vill. Basiyawan P.O. - Kalyanpur P.S - Pipra, Dist. Patna 804453.

4 BRANCH:

The trust can open a branch (s) at any place (s) within India or any Place (s) in abroad. At present, office of one branch of the Trust shall be at Prabha Niwas, Mohar Tola, Dariyapur Gola, P.O.- Bankipur, P.S.- Kadamkuan, District- Patna- 800004.

5 BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

TRUSTEES of the trust and they have accorded their consent to become the trustees of these present as testified by them being the parties too and executing the same and to act for the fulfillment of the main objects of the trust and will be member of the board of trustees. The board of trustees shall not exceed more than ten members including the author and shall not lesser than two

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including the author. The board of trustees can appoint any citizen of India competent to enter into a contract as trustee. The board of trustees shall be the apex board and under it, all the managing committee, working committee and advisory board shall function.

(i) RAJ KISHORE, S/O Vidya Nand Singh resident of Prabha Niwas, Mohar Tola, Dariyapur Gola, P.O - Bankipur, P.S – Kadamkuan, Dist. - Patna – 800004

(ii) BIRENDRA KUMAR SINGH, S/O RAM JATAN SINGH resident of Dahaurchak, P.O.- Patariya, Dist.-Jehanabad, Bihar-804454

(iii) SULEKHA DEVI, D/O SHRI BHAGVAN SINGH, Vill. – Basiyawan, P.O. – Kalyanpur, P.S - Pipra, Dist.-Patna -804453.

From herein after, the above trustees may also be referred to as the Permanent Trustees.

6 MAIN OBJECTS OF THE TRUST :

(i) To set up, develop, takeover a running school acquire, purchase, take franchises of a school, construct, maintain, run, support, educational institutions, schools, from pre to higher secondary, college, teacher's training college, engineering college, polytechnic college, ITI College, nursing training institute, any other type of technical education, institution, mass communication college etc. for the benefit and use of the public at large.

To promote construct, set up, improve, run develop and/or assist in construction, running, improving and/or developing clinics, hospital, dispensaries, super specialized pospital, Blood Bank, Serum deposit centre, medical college, dental college, para medical college, nurse training centres, pharmacy college, Homeopathic College, Ayurvedic College for imparting training, education and/or

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providing treatment facility especially to poor, schedule caste, schedule tribe, backward and other on no profit basis.

- (iii) To establish, improve, develop research institution, and/or do research work and/or to assist, support any institution involved in research work, in the field of allopath, ayurved, unani homeopath or desi chikitsa.
- (iv) To run, organize, support, program institution, facilities for spreading for spreading education and reducing illiteracy ratio from the society.
- (v) To establish, conduct, maintain, old age homes, homes for a physically challenged persons, blind persons, women and children and a persons with similar disabilities and also for granting financial assistance to institutions performing similar activities.
- (vi) To provide grants, scholarships, fellowships and other form of financial assistance to the needy and deserving students for pursuing academic, technical vocational education, skill etc.
- (vii) To promote environment protection, social awareness, pollution control health & family welfare program, women empowerment and enlistment program, child welfare and protection, consumer protection, stopping of child & women trafficking in rural as well urban area.
- (viii) Formation and management of self-help group, capacity building training programme for self-help group, loan promotion for selfhelp group.
- (ix) To promote and undertake programme for upliftment of poor, backward, economically backward, schedule caste & schedule tribe, women, girls, boys, handicapped person by imparting education, vocational or job oriented training.

pollution to establish modern hi- tech, satellite nurseries to cater to the growing demand of plants, trees, hedge, shrubs, flowers, vegetables, fruits and other botanical needs for furthering green

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and ecofriendly sustainable environment and agriculture.

(xi) To promote and undertake, run yoga programme for keeping the society healthy.

(xii) To educate people and run programme, seminar for eradication of social evils like dowry, child marriage, drug addiction, child labour, social abuse, child, women and girls trafficking and to provide other help line to destitute, orphans, windows, handicapped etc.

in any programme or activity intended to promote, the social, economic and/or moral development or upliftment of the poor, neglected person of the society, the handicapped and deserving person irrespective of caste, creed, religion or colour.

(xiv) To provide relief measure to the need and affected persons of during natural calamities like flood, fire, famine and earthquake, draught etc.

(xv) To conduct or assist in conducting activities of art music dance, drama, folklore, literature scientific and charitable nature to all or any of the objects mentioned herein.


(xvi) To support and render financial assistance to charitable and education cause and institutions, charitable companies, trust, societies or individuals in the form of donations, loans or otherwise on such terms and conditions as the board of trustees decides.

(xvii)To provide, render, impart, run vocational training programme, course particularly for girls and women for their economic independences.

(xviii) To provide, render, impart, run skilled development automobile training programme course for girls and women for their economic independents.

PROVIDED that the income and property of the trust howsoever derived, obtained, received shall be applied solely for and towards the achievement for the objects of the Trust as set forth above, and the same shall be deemed to be held in trust on the obligation that it shall be exclusively so utilized and for no other purpose. And no part

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of the income or property shall be paid, used, utilized and applied for the benefit of the AUTHOR or trustees either by way of dividend, interest or any other means.

payment in good faith or remuneration to the trustees for extra services render by them or to any person for any services rendered and any lawful expenses incurred by them on behalf of the trust.

7. SOURCES OF INCOME:

- (i) By Government aids.
- (ii) By gift or donation from members, other individual, private firms, companies and /or organization, trust, society and / or from foreign source as donation, gift etc.
- (iii) By loan from members, person/ Government/Banks/ Financial Institution or any other Institution.
- (iv) By any other legal sources.

8 TRUST FUND:-

The expression "Trust Fund" appearing anywhere in the presents will mean and include the movable property and will be deemed to include all monies received as loan, grant in aid, donation, gift or by sale or disposal of any trust property, movable and any money received or recovered by any other way of surplus, income, gain from the Trust Fund or property or in any other from or by any other way whatsoever.

TRUST PROPERTY:

The expression "Trust Property" appearing in the presents will mean and include all other movable or improvable properties or other intangible rights received/

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possessed by the Trust, in its name, by way of loan, grant in aid, donation, grant in aid, gifts or purchases or other mode of acquisition or by any other way whatsoever.

10. APPLICATION OF INCOME:-

The Managing Trustees shall, out of the gross income to be accrued, from the Trust property and Trust Fund shall spent for satisfying all the liabilities, taxes, expenses incurred for achieving the object of the Trust.

11. INSURANCE OF THE PROPERTY:-

All the assets and property shall be properly and timely of insured to protect from any loss to be caused by natural calamities, theft or otherwise.

12. BANKACCOUNT:-

A bank account shall be opened in any scheduled commercial bank and the same bank account shall be operated jointly by any of the two persons (i) Raj Kishore (ii) Birendra Kumar Singh (iii) Sulekha Devi or by the persons as decided by the board of trustees from time to time after passing a resolution by simple majority but not less than two Trustees or persons jointly as decided by the board of trustees.

13. ACCOUNTS OF THE TRUST FUND AND PROPERTY:-

The trustees shall keep and maintain proper and regular accounts of the Trust Fund, Income and expenditure Account and Receipt and payment Account for a

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financial year starting from 1st April to next 31st March. The account of the first year shall be of period from the date of registration of the trust to next 31st March. It should be signed by at least two Trustees and sent for audit to a duly qualified chartered accountant, who will be appointed by the board of trustees. After receipt of the financial statement along with audit report thereof, it shall be placed before the board of trustees and; after approval and adoption the said financial account shall be treated as final.

14. INVESTMENT OF FUND:-


The managing trustees shall invest the Trust Fund in the authorized securities including Bank Accounts or deposits, debentures of public undertaking as specified under the Income Tax Act, 1961 but not in the shares of any commercial companies and the incomes raised from such securities will only be used in used in carrying on the objects of the Trust. Investment mode may be changed from time to time as may be beneficial to the Trust and shall be decided by the board of trustees.

15. FUNDACCOUNT:-

All the bank account shall be opened and maintained in name of the Trust. All the Bank accounts shall be operated by the persons as mentioned at Para 12 above or as decided by the board of trustees of the trust from time to time after passing a resolution by simple majority.

16. FUNCTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind from any person, body or body of persons or trust with or without conditions in name of the trust but the terms and conditions shall not be in any case inconsistent or repugnant to the trust



object.


- (ii) To apply the whole or part of the income of the trust fund or accumulation thereof to any one or more of the objects of the trust as the trustees determine in their discretion from time to time.
- (iii) To administer, control and appoint managing committee i.e. the managing trustees.
- (iv) To make changes, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the trust and for management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the object of the trust.
- (v) To set apart and/ or allocate the whole or part of the income of the corpus of the trust fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the trust.
- (vi) To get the account of the trust audited every year by a chartered accountant who shall be appointed by the board.
- (vii) The audited account of the trust shall be adopted by the board in a meeting called for the purpose.
- (viii) The board shall manage the affairs of the trust, the overall supervision and control of the trust, all institutions run under the umbrella of the trust and any other matter incidental thereto.
- (ix) To call meeting and quorum for the meeting shall be at least two third of the members of the board but not less than three in any case.
- (x) If meeting adjourn due to quorum the adjourn meeting shall be held on same day, same time and same place in the next week.

17. MANAGING TRUSTEES:

The board of trustees shall appoint the member of managing trustees. The president, secretory & treasurer of the trust will be elected by the managing trustee in its otherwise so decided by the Board of trustees. The

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managing trustees can delegates their power to working committee and the working committee shall act and function as prescribed or specified by the managing trustees. The managing committee shall not be empowered to invest in immovable property or sell or disposal of immovable property without having prior approval of the board of trustees.

18. APPOINTMENT OF ADDITIONAL TRUSTEES:

Trustee, if think fit to carry out the objects of the Trust more effectively and efficiently, but in no case the total number of the Trustees including author, at any point of time, shall be more than ten. In the event of ceasing of any Trustee by reason of death, resignation or physical or mental incapacity or otherwise, the remaining Trustees shall have power to appoint any other person in his/her place as trustee.

19. VACANCY IN THE BOARD TRUSTEES:

A vacancy shall be caused in the board of trustees:

- a. When he/shedie.
- b. Disclaims.
- Desirous of discharge.
- d. If he/ she refuse to act.
- e. If he/she is found to be unsound mind by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- f. If he is convicted by a court for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than six months.
 - He/she becomes unfit or incapable to act as trustee.

If he/she declares insolvent.

If he/she makes obstruction in execution of the resolution passed by two third majority.





The trustees affected shall be given reasonable opportunity to show cause against the proposed action.

On death of a permanent trustee or on becoming him/her incompetent for any reason, the legal heirs or the legal representatives (as per the will or testament, if any, of the deceased permanent trustee) of the said permanent trustee shall be appointed as a trustee in place of the said permanent trustee. The trustee so appointed in place of a permanent trustee shall also be treated as the permanent trustee.

20. POWER OF THE MANAGING TRUSTEES:

The managing Trustees shall have the following general powers save as otherwise provided in this present :-

- (i) To receive loan, donations or gifts, grant in aid in money or in kind on such terms & conditions as the trustees may agree upon from any person, members, institution, bank or etc. and which are not inconsistent with the object of the Trust.
- (ii) To acquire movable property, required for carrying out the objects of the Trust, by way of purchase, lease, gift constructions or on lease license basis or otherwise howsoever.
- (iii) To acquire or sell any immovable property or any part there of or give on lease immovable property or part thereof not required for carrying out the objects of the Trusts subject to the approval of the board of trustees and any authority if required under any law.
 - the Trustees in formulation of general policies of in such other matters as are referred to them, provided however that it shall be open to the managing trustees to accept or not to accept their advice wholly, partly or to reject it.

To form working committee for a particular or general work.

To sanction recurring and non-recurring expenses from

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month to month required for in connection with carrying out the object of the trust.

- (vii) To institute, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjust, settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceeding or dispute, claim, demand or if think proper for such purpose without being responsible or any loss occasioned thereby.
- (viii) To invest, dispose of, transfer or otherwise deal with the funds of the trust subject to the provisions of any law to that effect in such manner as the Trustees may deem fit so as enable them to carry out the objects of the Trust effectively and efficiently.
- (ix) And generally to do any other acts or act not mentioned above that might be necessary to the discharge of their duties and execution of the powers vested in them.
- (x) To acquire by lease, Purchase, gift, mortgage, license as beneficiary under any other Trust or otherwise lands, properties, machinery etc. from Government or semi Government authorities, trusts and corporations, institution and societies as well as individuals, to sell, alienate, gift lease mortgage manage or in any other legal manner transfer properties belong to the Trust and also to give the same on lease or license for the furtherance of the object of the Trust.
- (xi) To raise secured or unsecured loan from any scheduled commercial Bank or any other financial institutions or firm or individual or as any other institution including any registered society or trust with or without interest whenever necessary for furthering of objects of the Trust.
- (xii) To receive voluntary donations in cash and kind from any person, individual or associations for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust.
 - To receive grant in aid from any government, institution, trust, society, or non-profit organization for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust.

xiv) To frame rules or bylaws and other codes for the conduct

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of the affairs of the Trust. All such rules, bylaws or codes of the conduct framed by the managing trustees shall either have been approved by the board of trustees by at least two third majority or shall be put before the immediate next meeting of the board of trustees for approval by at least two third majority. Any rules, bylaws or code of conduct, which is not approved by the board of trustees, will be seized to exist for the function of the trust.

21. MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

The Trustees may at any convenient place and at convenient intervals hold meeting from time to time, on occasion when it shall be required for the transaction of business of the Trust. But in no case less than two meetings in a financial year shall be held.

The meeting shall be called, convened and held as may be prescribed by the bye - laws of the trust.

22. REMUNERATION TO TRUSTEES:

The Trustees shall not be entitled for any remuneration or to pay any remuneration to any person for acting as Trustees out of Trust Fund, but if they provide extra service to the trust then for that they will be entitled to get the remuneration as prescribed by the board of trustees.

23. REIMBURSEMENTTOTRUSTEES:

The Trustee may reimburse themselves or pay and discharge out of the Trust Fund all expenses properly incurred in or about the execution of the objects of the Trust/or powers under this Trust or any of them.

Provided however that this right and/or power of reimbursement shall not be operative in case of a Trustee

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held liable for the loss caused to the Trust for his/her acts of commission of fraud or misconduct.

24. REMOVALOFTRUSTEES:

Apart from death or resignation etc. a Trustee can be removed from the board of trustees or managing trustees. For this, approval of at least two third but not less than three existing Trustees is a precondition. Further, the trustee who is subject to removal shall be entitled to get not less than one month notice before his removal for presenting his/her case and after consideration of that he/she will be removed from trustees and from the date of resolution passed in the meeting he shall be ceased to be a trustee from that date. But only due to difference in opinion amongst the trustees no trustee can be removed unless and until his/her act is detrimental and against to the interest of the trust and its objects.

25. MEMBERSHIP OF THE TRUST:

Any individual citizen of India, at least age of eighteen, of sound mind, not convicted by any court or insolvent, of any cast and creed or religion may take membership of the trust after paying the subscription as determined or fixed by the managing committee. If subscription is not received within two months since it becomes due then his/her membership will automatically be ceased. A member can resign any time within the period of currency of his membership. The member should participate in the working of the trust as and when required by the trustees.

26. AMENDMENT OF THE TRUST:

In all the case in which it is found necessary or desirable to insert or delete, add or amend any clause of the Trust, BALANS BALANS

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the Board of Trustees shall have the right under this trust to make such insertion, addition, deletion and the managing trustees shall apply to the appropriate authority for giving effects where the such approval of statutory authority or a court of law is required.

27. IRREVOCABILITY:

The Trust shall be an irrevocable trust.

28. RESOLUTION:

The Trustees may exercise all the powers vested in them under these presents by resolution passed at a simple majority of the trustees attended such meeting of the Board or Trustees.

Any resolution in writing signed by all Trustees holding office for the time being shall be valid and binding. It may be altered, changed or removed by the same way as described above or by at least two-third majority of the Board of Trustees.

29. INDEMNITY:

Every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the fund in respect of any loss arising from or contingent upon any investment made out of the monies of the Trust unless such loss shall have been occasioned by own negligence and also every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the Trust against all proceedings, suits, claims, costs, damages and expenses occasioned by any claim in connection with the matters of affairs relating to the Trust created by these presents or in the exercise of powers or discretion vested in them by virtue of these presents.

The Trustee shall be chargeable only for such monies,

stocks, funds deposits, and securities, movable or immovable properties as these shall actually be received by him/her with proper receipts for the sake of conformity and shall be accountable only for his/her own deliberate or willful acts of omission or commission.

No trustee shall be liable for any breach of trust committed by the co-trustee except in respect of his own act in respect of any property in his custody. Every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the fund in respect of any loss arising from or contingent upon any investment made out of the monies of the Trust unless such loss shall have been occasioned by own negligence and also every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the Trust against all proceedings, suits, claims, costs damages and expenses occasioned by any claim in connection with the matters of affairs relation to the Trust created by these presents or in the exercise of powers or discretion vested in them by virtue of these presents.

30. RULES AND REGULATION OF THE TRUST:

The Trustee shall have power from time to time to frame rules and regulations as they may think fit and proper for the administration and carrying out the provisions of this Trust and to provide for the Management of Trust Fund and also from time to time alter any such rules and regulations or to repeal them and substitute other in their place, provided always that no such rule or regulation as framed or subsequently amended shall in any manner be inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Trust.

DISSOLUTION:

On dissolution of the Trust, the net assets of the Trust shall be transferred to an association of persons or trust or society having similar objects of this Trust.

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32. JURISDICTION OF THE COURTS:

The competent courts in Patna shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide any question regarding the interpretation and construction of this deed or administration of the Trust and the related matters. In the event of such courts having jurisdiction with any other court or courts in respect of any claim or dispute against by the Trust or Trustees or any other matter connected therewith, the competent courts in Patna shall have jurisdiction to entertain, try and determine such claims or dispute in exclusion of such other court or courts;




